

Mens Netball NSW -

State team uniform policy



Introduction

This policy sets out the uniform requirements for all athletes, officials (including coaches, assistant coaches and managers) and primary care staff appointed to Mens Netball NSW (MNNSW) state teams.

This policy sits alongside MNNSW's other policies. It is important that you familiarise yourself with MNNSW's other policies.

Primary colours

MNNSW official colours are sky blue and navy.

Uniforms – athletes

Competition Uniform

The following uniform must be worn by all MNNSW state team athletes during competition at the National Championships:

- MNNSW official playing uniform
- Navy boy leg sports briefs (Females only)
- MNNSW track pants or shorts
- MNNSW hoodie or soft shell jacket
- MNNSW blue travel polo shirt
- MNNSW training singlet
- MNNSW backpack or sports bag
- MNNSW or white socks

During competition warm up, athletes are permitted to wear any combination of the official uniform provided they are all dressed similarly within their respective teams.

Uniform – team officials

It is expected that MNNSW state team officials are to be dressed similarly at all times. Officials can choose from either option of Competition Uniform or Training Uniform during competition and training.

Competition Uniform and Official Functions

The following uniform must be worn by all officials appointed to MNNSW state team during on court events or other official functions:

- Navy mid length or longer skirt, dress pants or dress shorts.
- MNNSW official embroidered white dress shirt or official white polo (MNNSW will provide 1 to each team official).
- Black, brown or navy shoes that are appropriate to the tasks involved in performing within the role.
- MNNSW Hoodie or Soft shell jacket

Training Uniform

The following uniform must be worn by all officials appointed to MNNSW state team during training sessions and games prior to the Australian Championships:

- Navy tracksuit pants or shorts
- MNNSW white polo shirt
- Other form of MNNSW branded clothing (eg training singlet)

Uniform – primary care staff

To assist the primary care staff in performing the necessary tasks within their role, they can choose to wear comfortable clothing (eg shorts

or tracksuit) in a navy colour along with a MNNSW official white polo shirt and shoes that are appropriate to the tasks involved in performing within the role.

Travel

When over 80% of a State Team is traveling together to the host city of the Australian Championships, the uniform requirements to be worn during travelling are:

- MNNSW Track Pants or shorts
- MNNSW Blue Travel Polo shirt
- MNNSW Hoodie or Soft shell jacket
- MNNSW White Official polo shirt - officials only

Player travelling may wear jeans with the with travel shirt if agreed by the Team Officials.

Sponsorship

If any uniform has been provided by a team or event sponsor for the Australian Championships, athletes and officials must wear the sponsor's clothing whenever the team is together during the course of the Australian Championships (eg travelling to and from courts).

What happens if uniforms are not ready

If uniforms are not ready for training sessions, it should be noted that unmarked clothing should be worn and no other branded clothing worn (eg Indoor Netball clothing).
