- Assist with selection of teams at trials in November/December (COVID permitting)
- Create and drive a positive culture at association and team level
- Develop a Program with a focus on individual growth both on and off the court
- Be available for team training sessions between November and April
- Be available and actively contribute with the Mentoring program run by Men's Netball High Performance Delegate
- Be available to attend scheduled events in the metropolitan and regional areas
- To be familiar with and adhere to all Men's Netball NSW policies and programmes
- Attend all meetings as determined by the Men's Netball NSW committee

All Coach applicants must have the communication skills to connect and engage with athletes and coaches to deliver a positive experience.

Coaches will be supported throughout the program with mentoring where appropriate and will play a significant role in the future success of Men's Netball in NSW.

Applicants should have a minimum Netball Australia Intermediate Coach Accreditation.
