Role Outline: Men's Netball NSW Coach

The state team coaches of Men's Netball NSW are responsible for individual development of representative players and contributing to the continued growth of Men's and Mixed Netball within NSW. The position is contracted between September 2022 and July 2023.

The MNNSW State Coach will be responsible for:

- Providing feedback to the MNNSW Selection Panel at player trials.
- Creating and driving a positive culture at association and team level
- Developing a strong High Performance Program with a focus on individual growth both on and off the court
- Attending team/squad training sessions and any competitions / events between September and July
- Actively contribute in the Mentoring program run by Men's Netball High Performance Consultant
- Ensuring their availability to attend scheduled events in the metropolitan and regional areas including any development events
- Ensuring they are familiar with and adhere to all Men's Netball NSW policies and programmes
- Attend all meetings as determined by the Men's Netball NSW committee

All Coach applicants must have the communication skills to connect and engage with athletes and coaches to deliver a positive experience. Coaches will be supported throughout the program with mentoring where appropriate and will play a significant role in the future success of Men's Netball in NSW.

In accordance with Child Protection legislation candidates will be required to provide a Working with Children Check (WWCC) clearance number for verification by Men's Netball NSW prior to appointment.

Applicants should have a minimum Netball Australia Intermediate Coach Accreditation.
